King Penguin, Aptenodytes patagonicus

Breeds in huge colonies of up to 250,000 pairs



**Emperor Penguin**, Aptenodytes fosteri

Only bird to breed in the Antarctic winter



Adélie Penguin, Pygoscelis adeliae

Breeds farther south than any other bird (Cape Royds in Antarctica)



**Chinstrap Penguin**, Pygoscelis antarctica

Most abundant Antarctic penguin (over 7 million)



**Gentoo Penguin**, Pygoscelis papua

Fastest swimming penguin (reaches speeds of 22 mph)



Yellow-eyed Penguin, Megadyptes antipodes

Least social of all penguin species



**Southern Rockhopper** Penguin,

*Eudyptes chrysocome* 

Has beautiful ruby-red eyes



**Northern Rockhopper** Penguin,

Eudyptes moseleyi

Can jump up to six feet



**Erect-crested Penguin,** Eudyptes sclateri

The only species that can raise and lower its crest



Fiordland Penguin, **Eudyptes pachyrhynchus** 

The only penguin species that has a series of white lines on its cheeks



**Snares Penguin, Eudyptes robustus** 

The smallest range of any penguin (endemic to a small area of New Zealand's **Snares Island)** 



Macaroni Penguin, **Eudyptes chrysolophus** 

Named for a pasta after

fancy-dressed Americans ("Yankee doodle dandy" with a "feather in his cap")



**Royal Penguin,** Eudyptes schlegeli

The friendliest and most curious of the penguins



**African Penguin**, Spheniscus demersus

Arguably the most endangered penguin (down over 95% in the last century)



Magellanic Penguin, Spheniscus magellanicus

Named for the Portuguese explorer, Ferdinand Magellan



**Humboldt Penguin**, Spheniscus humboldti

Blushes to cool off in its desert environment




Galápagos Penguin, Spheniscus mendiculus

The only penguin species north of the Equator



Little Penguin, Eudyptula minor

This is the only species of penguin that is not black and white—it is blue and white
